**Short description of IPSE Programme :** The Certificate in Disability-Inclusive Practice is one-year course. Classes take place 2 days per week from September to April, followed by a 3-month work placement. Students develop their presentation skills, communication skills, and self-advocacy skills.

The course is underpinned by a rights-based agenda, and provides opportunities for co-learning between students with and without disabilities, for mutual benefit. This promotes awareness raising and reciprocal learning.
